Processing purposes

Connected-Pathology BV collects and processes personal data for, among other things, administration, follow-up of orders/deliveries, invoicing, follow-up of solvency, profiling and sending marketing and personalized advertising.

Legal grounds for processing

Personal data is processed on the basis of consent, necessary for the performance of a contract, necessary to comply with a legal obligation, necessary for the protection of our legitimate interest to do business. Each person always has the right to withdraw the given consent.

Transfer to third parties

If necessary for the achievement of the aforementioned purposes, the personal data will be shared with third parties within the European Economic Area that are directly or indirectly linked to **Connected-Pathology BV** or with any other partner of **Connected-Pathology BV**.

Connected-Pathology BV guarantees that these recipients will take the necessary technical and organizational measures to protect the personal data.

Retention period

Personal data will be kept for the period necessary to comply with legal requirements (including in the field of accounting).

Right of access, rectification, erasure, restriction, objection and transferability of personal data

Each person has at any time the right to access his personal data and may correct it (or have it corrected) if it is incorrect or incomplete, have it deleted, restrict its processing and object to the processing of personal data concerning him.

In addition, any person has the right to obtain a copy (in a structured, accessible and machine-readable form) of their personal data and to have their personal data transmitted to third parties.

WHAT ARE COOKIES?
